Accompany

Definition:

(what does it mean?)

If we accompany someone it means we go somewhere with them. It can also mean we play along with someone on an instrument.

Synonyms (what is the word similar to?):

Escort, follow, go with.

Antonyms (what is the opposite of this?):

Abandon, desert, leave, neglect.

Related words (Do you know any different forms of the word? Are there any other words that are connected to this one in some way?): *Accompanies, accompanying, accompanied, accompaniment, company, companion, follow.*

Word Structure / Origins (do you recognize a common root word, prefix or suffix? What do these mean?):

The root word is *company*, which means to be with someone or a group of people.

Example sentences:

- I would like someone to accompany me to the ball.
- I will ask my friend to accompany me when I go to the shops.
- Children can only go in the restaurant if they are accompanied by an adult.
